MEEF AND THE NHS

- MEEF has been developed with the NHS as a core sector given its leadership in the low carbon sector.
- MEEF has access to £500m of financing that can provide funding for up to 100% of the capital cost of a project.
- MEEF can provide flexible loans to both NHS Trusts & NHS Foundation Trusts below rates from the NLF for up to 17 years
- MEEF has already created a suite of Energy Performance Contract (EPC) financing documents that have been designed for the NHS sector.
- MEEF can also provide framework loans, locking into a fixed interest rate, while allowing drawdowns over the period to 31 May 2023.
- Energy efficiency projects must create a 20% energy saving. All projects must save a tonne of CO2 per annum for every £14,000 of MEEF investment

INVESTMENT STRATEGY

- MEEF can support energy efficiency, decentralised energy, electric vehicle charging infrastructure, renewable energy generation projects including innovative technologies such as energy storage and low carbon data centres.
- MEEF can provide flexible and competitive funding for low carbon projects across the Capital, with loans from £1m to £20m.
- MEEF has available to it £2m of technical support funding that can be made available to support a project's business case accelerating the due diligence process.
- MEEF is funded with over £500m of commitments from the GLA, Amber and commercial funders. This provides MEEF with a breadth of funding appetite, allowing MEEF to deliver an appropriate suite of funders for each project.
